Central County Emergency 911 is looking for a full-time Network Technician to manage and maintain computer networks, connections, and cabling. The role involves troubleshooting system issues, resolving network infrastructure problems, testing and configuring software, installing and maintaining hardware, supporting network components, and assisting with network administration and security. The technician will also address issues across LAN, WAN, cloud networks, and servers.

This position supports daily operations within the Technical Services Division of Central County and will collaborate closely with Fire and EMS supervisory staff, government agencies, and public safety jurisdictions to coordinate operational efforts. A significant portion of work will involve fire stations and field work.

QUALIFICATIONS NEEDED FOR SUCCESS:
